NOTICE 1

MWFRA Final Refereed Branch Entry Course

The next and FINAL referees course is as follows: -

BELROSE BOWLING CLUB

Part 1 - Sunday 2nd May, 2010 (time 9.00am – 5.00pm)

Part 2 - Monday 3rd May, 2010 (time 6.30pm – 9.30pm)

Need to attend both to become an active Referee - (Limited places - no juniors)

Register via the link on the MWFRA website - www.mwfra.com.au

Places are limited and there will not be another course. **Teams without referees will be removed from the competition, no excuses.**

This is not just about getting your teams across the line. This is about complying with your obligation to provide a referee to either the game before or after yours when you are the home team.

NOTE: If you team has a referee without a PIN and the referee has done the course previously he/she will need to re-register with the Referees Association. Register on-line www.mwfra.com.au once this is done they will receive their PIN. If there are referees who think they have re-registered but have not received an email advising of their pin or how to log in to the new MWFRA system, please email the MWFA registrar, registrar@mwfra.com.au

Once you have received your log in information you can go to the site, log in and view your payroll/pin number. We must provide these numbers to the MWFA very soon.

Teams or referee(s) needing assistance with either registering or other questions, please contact your club secretary / team manager for assistance.

NOTICE 2

Drinking At The Grounds

For those spectators/parents or players who feel the need to consume alcohol at the grounds please note that the consumption of alcohol **is NOT PERMITTED AT ANY SCHOOL VENUE**. This is a Department of Education directive and our ongoing use of the grounds is reliant on our compliance. Any breaches of this condition will result in our sport no longer being allowed access to these grounds. With field availability already being a big issue for us, the loss these grounds will result in more Sunday games.

This was discussed at the last MWFA Council of Clubs meeting and the Clubs agreed to a new

rule that teams found breaching this condition and consuming alcohol on school premises will be subject to the following sequence of penalties: -

1. Formal warning
2. Loss of one match point
3. Loss of three match points.
4. Removal from competition.

NO GLASS BOTTLES are permitted at any sporting field. This is an enforceable Council regulation that is policed by Rangers. Apart from this there is the obvious risk factor to users of the grounds from broken glass when bottles are not disposed of properly.

When leaving a field, please remove all of your rubbish to the nearest bin. For those teams who may have an esky, perhaps from your "donations" you could purchase a packet of garbage bags to use when the bins are few and far between.

NOTICE 3

NETS – New Rules and Procedures

The abridged version is that every team who is first on or last off must take down or put up one end of nets. This applies wherever you are playing, not just for home games.

Compliance with this new rule (**9.0 Ground Setup and Takedown**) is appreciated.

Intent: The basis of this rule is to keep the Clubs responsible for the provision of the nets, flags and other setup materials (tape etc) at the ground and the teams playing the first or last game on a field responsible for setup / takedown respectively.

Procedure:

The following applies to all competition teams (U10 to All Age, O35 and O45 teams).

At least 45 minutes before the start of the first game on a field, the Club who is allocated the field by the MWFA must deliver nets, flags and other necessary items for the setup of the field. These must be placed at the centre of the field.

The teams who are playing the first game on the field on that day must each setup half the field, including the net in one goal and the flags for half a field. Any containers and other equipment must be stored near one of the goals. **This must be completed at least ten minutes before the start of the game.**

The teams who are playing on the last game on the field must each dismantle half a field and place the equipment in the containers provided in the middle of the field. Unless otherwise indicated this will be the 3pm game on any field. This includes corner flags and one net. The Club must then come and pick up the equipment for storage as appropriate.

In order that there is no possibility for ambiguity, each team will be responsible for the setup or takedown of half a field. It is up to the individual teams to decide which half of the field they will setup/take down.

Punishment:

If a team fails to perform this function the following penalties will be imposed:

- On the first offence a formal warning will be issued by the MWFA. The Club of the offending team must provide proof the team has received the notice.
- On the second occasion, the team will lose one match point

- On the third occasion, the team will lose three match points
- On the fourth occasion, the team will be asked to provide reasons as to why they should not be removed from the competition.

If a Club fails to provide the necessary equipment for setting up a ground in the required timeframe there is a fine of \$50 for the first offence and each subsequent offence will attract an additional \$50 fine. This includes adequate materials to adhere nets to goalposts.

The imposition of these penalties is at the discretion of the MC.

Exception:

At particular grounds Clubs may choose roster their own teams to set up and takedown fields. Clubs are requested to inform the MWFA of these fields and this information will be passed on to all Clubs.

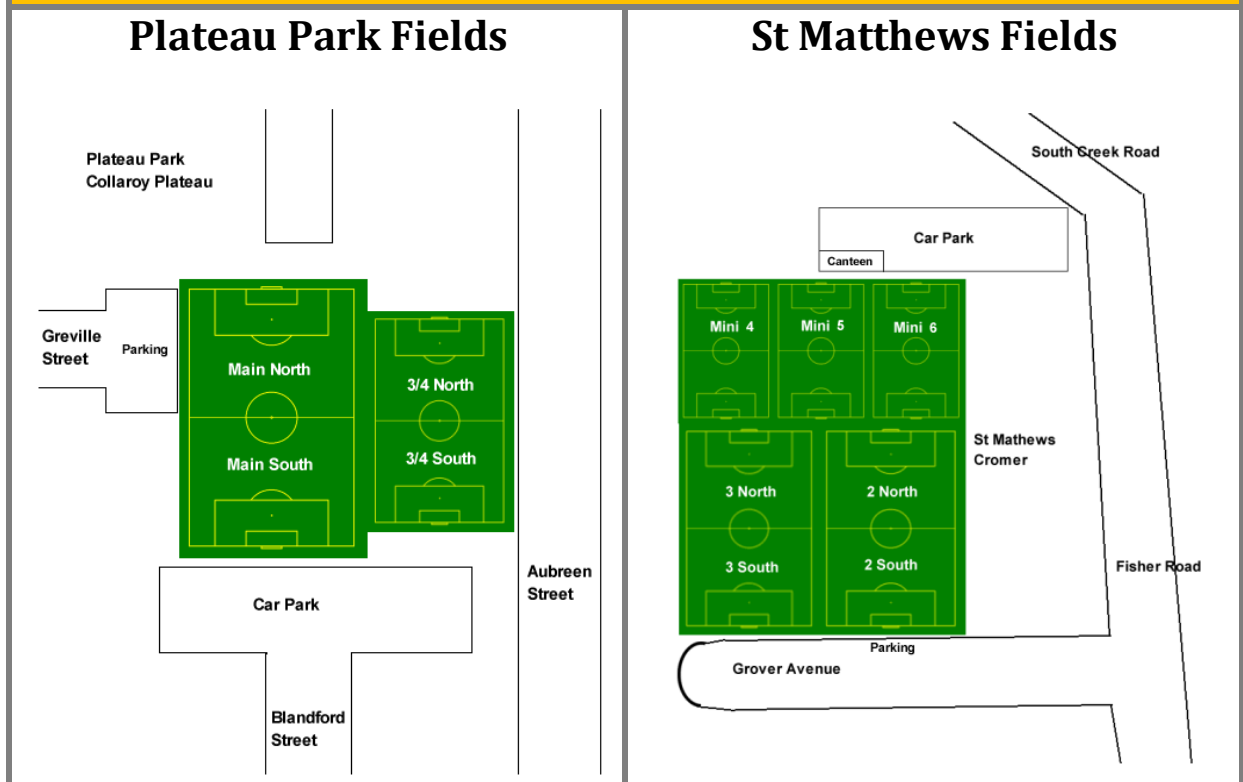
