Do You Know The Game?

4-2-3-1 System Formation (used by the Socceroos)

The Socceroos under the coaching of the Dutchman, Pim Verbeek, often play the unusual but pragmatic formation of 4-3-2-1. The Australian side has continued to use this formation since Guss Hiddink coached the side at the 2006 World Cup. This formation with the lone striker has been the preferred formation of Verbeek at many of the Aussie away matches.

Having only one forward (your fastest) pushed up all the time for breakaways means the team resorts to a counter-attacking style of play. In this formation you give up width in the attack to gain more depth.

It is said that the formation is used to encourage predictability and eliminate spontaneity. With several players who can play in various positions, use of the formation is a classic case of using a formation that suits the team – with the formation particularly suited to the ability of players, the players' speed and endurance, and the number of substitutes available.

On the field, Verbeek likes his players to do as they are told: with Kennedy or Cahill up front, with Kewell, Bresciano and Chipperfield doing the hard running as the midfield trio, with Grella and Culina as the holding pair (with Valeri as their replacement), and at the back Wilkshire, Carney, Neill, and Coyne (with Moore as their replacement), and last but not least Schwarzer as goalie, Verbeek is providing the Australian team with the best chance of being successful.

The formation may not win over the fans but it has certainly produced the result of winning games, with the Socceroos not scoring many goals but not conceding them either. Whether the coach will allow his team licence to attack in South Africa and open up teams remains the great imponderable.

Grading Sheets

All coaches of teams from Under 8s to Under 18s (mixed and girls) will soon be receiving team grading sheets via their team pigeonholes or email. The Grading Sheets require coaches to give an assessment of the ability of their players. The sheets are of enormous help in future gradings and assessments of players.

Return your completed Grading Sheet via a specific 'grading committee' pigeonhole at St Matthew's Farm or return it completed electronically via email.

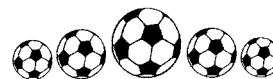
